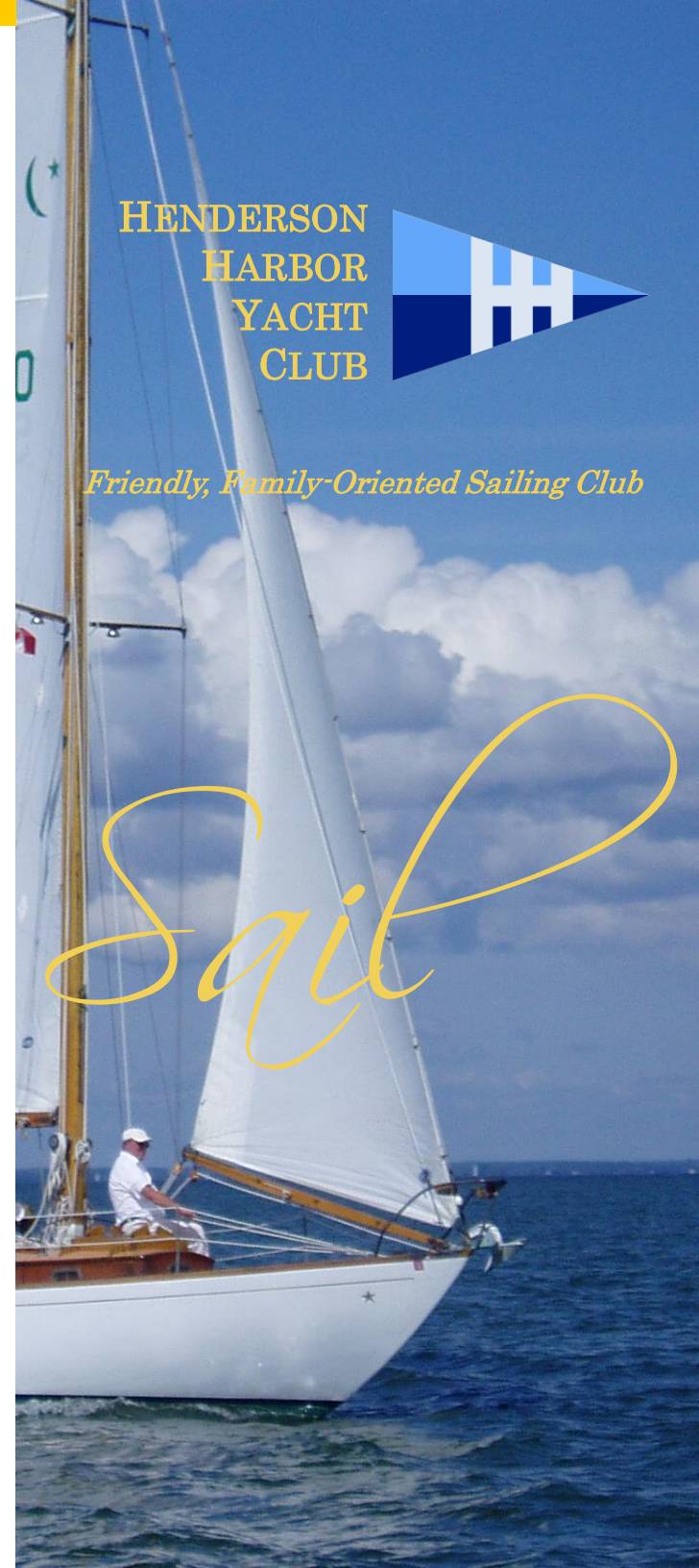

From Interstate 81, take exit 41, drive west on Route 178 for about 10 miles until you get to Henderson, take a left turn by the fire house and library. Proceed to a stop sign and cross Route 3. Turn right immediately onto Harbor Road. Proceed down the hill and take a left onto Cornell Road to Henderson Harbor Yacht Club.

Henderson Harbor Yacht Club is a center for camaraderie and good fellowship, and gives its young people the legacy and heritage of Henderson Harbor.

Henderson Harbor Yacht Club is an informal, family-oriented, volunteer based sailing and boating club that promotes yachting activities and water safety.

RACING

HHYC has a full schedule of racing for PHRF-rated keel boats. Both course racing and longer distance races are held within the sheltered Henderson Bay and surrounding waters. We also have two one-design fleets, Cape Dory Typhoons and Lightnings, that race weekly during the summer. Youth racing is offered through the Henderson Harbor Water Sports Program, which operates from the yacht club premises.

HHYC also hosts major annual regattas, including the Duck Island long distance race and the Jefferson County Hospice Charity Regatta. The club is a periodic host for the Eastern Yachting Circuit and a former host of the Lightning North American Championships.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

HHYC offers a full calendar of social events featuring parties on the pier, wine tasting, Tuesday night family-style dinners and restaurant-prepared Friday dinners. The clubhouse bar offers a cozy meeting place to replay the day's races or plan next week's cruise.

CLUBHOUSE

The clubhouse has a beautiful view of Henderson Harbor, and features a bar, dining room, kitchen, sun porch, and restrooms with hot showers. You can sit on the patio or under the large willow at picnic tables for lunch or happy hour. Relax on lawn chairs with a good book or sit and chat in the warm sun or cooling breeze.

DOCKAGE

Over 25 slips are available for members to lease, most with electric and water hookup.

SAILING AND SWIM SCHOOL

The Henderson Harbor Water Sports Program teaches sailing and swimming to youth and adults using the club facilities and a fleet of over 20 boats. It is a 501(C)(3) nonprofit corporation. See <https://www.hhwsp.com/> for more information.

WORK DAYS

HHYC is a volunteer club, which helps to keep dues reasonable. Spring and fall work days prepare the club and docks for summer and winter activities. Volunteering is also a social time of camaraderie, fun and hard work. Members who are unable to work are asked to make a donation to the club.

RECIPROCALLS

Club members enjoy reciprocal arrangements with 72 yacht clubs around the lake, reducing the cost of cruising for club members. HHYC welcomes yachts from other clubs to enjoy our facility, with access to dockage and clubhouse amenities.

MEMBERSHIP

We offer a variety of membership types to accommodate all who wish to join and use the club for boating or social events. This includes families with smaller boats or seasoned sailors with keel boats. The club also owns a 19-foot Cape Dory Typhoon that is available to members, for those who want to try sailing without the hassle of boat ownership. We also have kayaks that members can launch and use from the waterfront. We welcome an opportunity to discuss a membership level to suit your particular interest and need.

This charming cottage on the water front is available for members and non-members and includes access to all the club facilities and events for a modest weekly rental fee.

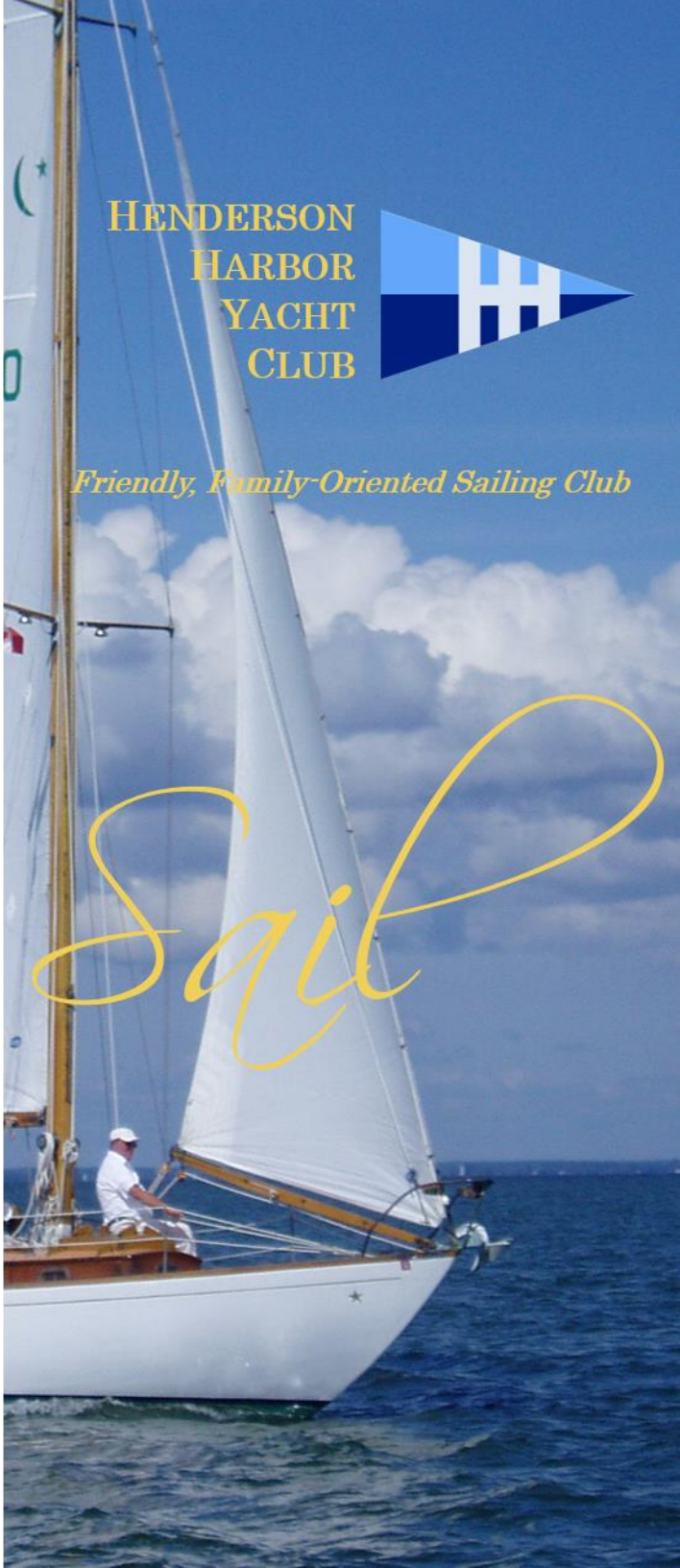
